FACULTIES



The Fergana Medical Institute of Public Health (FMIPH) features a distinguished faculty that blends local expertise with international experience. Among them is Dr. Rohith Krishnan, a Malayalee from the anatomy department, bring valuable knowledge from top Indian institutions. Dr. Krishnan's interactive teaching style and research on health equity enrich the academic environment. With both Indian and Uzbek faculty, FMIPH provides a well-rounded education that combines local healthcare insights with global perspectives, preparing students to tackle healthcare challenges worldwide.

HOSTEL FACILITIES, LECTURE HALLS AND CLASSROOMS, STUDENT-STAFF RATIO

FMIPH offers well-rounded facilities, including comfortable hostel accommodation for male and female students with a capacity of 750 beds, featuring fully furnished rooms, Wi-Fi, an Indian-style mess, cafeteria, and recreational amenities that create a homely environment. The institute also provides modern, well-ventilated lecture halls and classrooms equipped with ergonomic seating and advanced multi-media tools to support interactive and engaging learning. Additionally, FMIPH maintains an optimal student-staff ratio of 12-15 students per teacher, ensuring personalized attention, effective mentorship, and a supportive academic atmosphere.



LIBRARY, LABORATORIES, AUDITORIUM



The FMIPH campus is equipped with advanced academic and support facilities, including a well-established library that serves as a premier medical reference center with an extensive collection of books, journals, and digital resources, along with a spacious reading area for study and research. The institute also features state-of-the-art, air-conditioned laboratories with modern medical equipment, virtual simulation tools, and a dedicated Simulation Center that enables students to practice clinical skills

and handle real-life medical scenarios. Additionally, FMIPH houses a large, fully equipped auditorium with a seating capacity of over 2,000, designed to host academic events, seminars, and cultural programs, thereby enhancing both learning and campus life.



HOSPITAL



FMIPH is affiliated with its own 3,530-bed hospital, providing students with hands-on clinical experience. The hospital is equipped with modern medical facilities, offering a wide range of healthcare services to the community. It serves as a key learning environment for students to apply theoretical knowledge in real-world medical scenarios.

INDIAN EMBASSY PROGRAMS



The Indian Embassy in Tashkent conducts 75% of its programs at the Fergana Medical Institute of Public Health (FMIPH), making the institute a key hub for cultural, educational, and diplomatic activities. These programs include academic collaborations, cultural exchanges, and various initiatives that foster stronger ties between India and Uzbekistan. The presence of such programs at FMIPH not only enriches the students' learning experience but also provides them with valuable exposure to Indian culture, diplomacy, and international relations, creating a vibrant and globally connected campus environment.

CULTURAL AND SOCIAL EVENTS

FMIPH actively encourages students to participate in cultural events such as festivals, talent shows, and theatrical performances. COURSE ELIGIBILITY



In Uzbekistan, the MBBS program is referred to as the MD General Physician course, which is equivalent to the MBBS degree in India. To be eligible, applicants must have completed their secondary school education (12th grade) or an equivalent qualification with a focus on science subjects (Biology, Physics, and Chemistry), with a minimum of 60% in these subjects. Students must be at least 17 years old at the time of admission, with no upper age limit. Admission also requires passing an entrance exam that evaluates knowledge in Biology, Chemistry, and General Knowledge. For international students, the course is offered in English.



MBBS Course Details and Structure

The MBBS course at Fergana Medical Institute of Public Health (FMIPH) spans 6 years, with the first 5 years focused on foundational medical knowledge and clinical training, and the final year dedicated to internships and practical experience.

FIRST YEAR

ANATOMY:

Structure and function of the human body, with an emphasis on systems like skeletal, muscular, circulatory, and nervous systems.

PHYSIOLOGY:

Study of normal bodily functions, including respiration, circulation, digestion, and homeostasis.

BIOCHEMISTRY:

The chemistry of living organisms, including metabolism, enzymes, and molecular genetics.

HISTOLOGY:

Study of tissues under a microscope, focusing on cellular structures.

MEDICAL PHYSICS:

Principles of physics as they apply to medicine, such as radiation and imaging techniques.

SECOND YEAR

MICROBIOLOGY:

Introduction to microbiology, including bacteria, viruses, fungi, and parasites that cause diseases.

PATHOLOGY:

Basic principles of disease, including mechanisms, causes, and effects on the body.

PHARMACOLOGY:

Study of drugs, their effects on the body, and how they are used in medical treatments.

IMMUNOLOGY:

The immune system, including its response to infections, autoimmune diseases, and vaccines.

MEDICAL ETHICS:

Basic principles of ethics in medicine, patient care, and clinical practice.



THIRD YEAR

CLINICAL MEDICINE I:

Introduction to diagnosing and treating common diseases in internal medicine.

SURGERY I:

Basics of surgical practice, wound care, aseptic techniques, and emergency care.

PEDIATRICS:

Study of childhood diseases, growth and development, and pediatric care.

OBSTETRICS AND GYNECOLOGY:

Female reproductive health, pregnancy, childbirth, and women's health issues.

PSYCHIATRY:

Mental health disorders, diagnosis, and treatment approaches.

OPHTHALMOLOGY:

Basics of eye diseases, diagnosis, and treatment methods.

OTOLARYNGOLOGY (ENT):

Study of ear, nose, and throat diseases.

FOURTH YEAR

INTERNAL MEDICINE II:

Advanced study in treating internal diseases, including cardiology, gastroenterology, nephrology, and more.

SURGERY II:

Advanced surgical techniques and procedures, including major surgeries and specialties.

NEUROLOGY:

Study of the nervous system, including common neurological diseases like stroke, epilepsy, and Parkinson's disease.

ORTHOPEDICS:

Focus on musculoskeletal diseases and injuries.

DERMATOLOGY:

Diagnosis and treatment of skin diseases.

RADIOLOGY:

Use of medical imaging for diagnosing diseases (X-rays, MRIs, CT scans).

FIFTH YEAR

CARDIOLOGY:

Study of the heart, cardiovascular diseases, and their treatments.

GASTROENTEROLOGY:

Study of digestive diseases, liver, pancreas, and intestines.

ENDOCRINOLOGY:

Disorders of hormones and the endocrine system (e.g., diabetes, thyroid disorders).

UROLOGY:

Study of the urinary system and kidney diseases.

EPIDEMIOLOGY AND PUBLIC HEALTH:

Understanding disease patterns, prevention strategies, and public health approaches to health promotion.

SIXTH YEAR

INTERNSHIP:

The final year focuses on clinical rotations in hospitals, clinics, and other healthcare facilities. Students are required to work under the supervision of experienced doctors, practicing clinical skills, diagnostics, and treatment.

FINAL EXAMS:

At the end of the internship, students must pass comprehensive exams before being awarded the MBBS degree.



FEE STRUCTURE

The annual fee for the MBBS course at Fergana Medical Institute of Public Health (FMIPH) is \$3,600 per year, with additional costs such as food, accommodation, visa, government registration, and medical insurance.
